1. What is iVision 2025 – Youth Parliament?

- iVision Youth Parliament is a **platform for students to speak, think, and lead** like real changemakers.
- You will **represent a country or role** and give your views on a global, national, or state issue.
- It is **not a test** — it’s about **your voice, your ideas, and your solutions**.
- The event gives students a **real feel of parliamentary consultations** and how governments and the UN work through dialogue.

2. Your Role as a Delegate

- Represent the **country/role allotted** to your school.
- Learn **basic facts** about your topic (from your briefing sheet).
- Prepare a **1–2 minute speech** that includes:
 - What the **problem** is
 - How it affects your country or community
 - What **solutions** can be worked on
- Speak **clearly**, listen to others, and respect the process.

4. How to Make Your Opening Speech

1. Start with:
“Honourable Chair, respected delegates and fellow participants...”
2. Introduce your role or country:
“I represent [Country/Role Name].”
3. Talk about the issue:
“In our country, [brief explanation].”
4. Propose your solution:
“We believe that [your idea].”
5. End respectfully:
“Thank you.”

Tip: Speak slowly. Take your time. Smile. Don't memorize — **understand your point.**

5. Flow of the Day – Mandal Youth Parliament

Step	Activity	Description
1	Registration	You will sign in and receive your country/role placard
2	Opening Ceremony	Welcome and event instructions
3	Committee Session	Your turn to deliver a 1–2 min speech
4	Consultations	Moderated & unmoderated discussions
5	Youth Action Plan	Working in groups to draft simple solutions
6	Closing & Awards	Recognition for participants and winners
